


Mission and Vision




Mission: We exist to ensure learning for all students.


Students in K-5 do 5 week rotations with each magnet teacher!




Program Details:

- New! This year we implemented a House system! A proven campus-wide, student-driven incentive and community-building system. Students are sorted into one of five houses and represent his/her house every day through positive citizenship and academic excellence.
- Project-Based Model(PBL): Our week-long project schedule allows students to deeply explore different materials & concepts.
- Students in K-5th have the opportunity to develop oral, written, & visual communication skills through a wide range of experiences within our integrated curriculum.




Campus Logistics



- **School Hours:** 7:00–3:00 pm
- **Pick up/Drop Off:** White doors
- **Meals:** Breakfast & Lunch is provided, but students may bring their own
- **School Attire:** No uniforms, use appropriate tops and bottoms and tennis shoes!
- **Attendance:** Good attendance is required.
 - Excused absences include: illness, death in the family, & emergency situations
 - Unexcused absences: occur when an excuse is not communicated within 3 days & all vacations will be unexcused



Sample Kinder Schedule




- **7:15-7:45** - Student arrival, breakfast, independent activities
- **7:45-11:00** - Calendar/Morning message. Literacy block(Reading & Writing): Vocabulary development, whole group instruction, small group instruction/guided reading, workstations
- **11:00-11:30** - Lunch
- **11:30-12:10** - Recess & Restroom
- **12:10-1:15** - Math: Direct instruction, small groups, & workstations
- **1:15-2:00** - Magnet Class
- **2:00-2:45** - Science/Social Studies
- **2:45-2:55** - Reflection, closing, dismissal

All documents need to be ready to be presented when our school SIR contacts you.

- Birth Certificate
- Immunization Record
- Social Security Card
- Parent's ID
- Proof Of Residency (light, water, gas, or lease ONLY!)
- Final Report Card from previous campus (if applicable)




Enrollment Process for Kindergarten



- We will review entries checking birthdays and address to confirm zoning and age eligibility
- Once the district opens enrollment for the 2026 – 2027 school year, we will email you the Online Application Link.
- We anticipate space availability for zoned families if they enroll early **and** are here on Day 1!
- Pre-K enrollment does not roll over, you must submit an application, this is for both zoned and unzoned!
